
Especially for the nutritional requirements of turtles

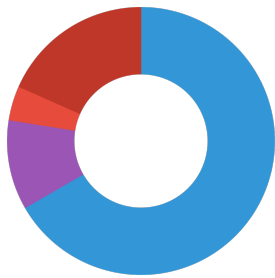
